How is the programme structured?

Each session is conducted under strict Chatham House rules commencing at 10am and concluding at 1pm.

The programme is structured around experienced leadership led case studies that illustrate success and failure; are applicable across sectors; enable discussion of key strategic challenges facing leaders and the key skills or attributes they need to possess.
